Important Information from the PSAA Board

Senior Divisions: The trial for the Senior XPlus Division will continue and the numbers will be looked at after the 2018 season to determine if it will become permanent.

Animal Round Change: Effective for 2018 – the sticker dots will not be placed on the animal. The current ring on the printed animal will be used as an X for tie breakers.

TARGET ROUND: Effective for 2018- target butts with 3 or more shooters will be permitted to opt to hang 2 smaller targets (from the 6 ring in) if the entire target butt agrees.

ATTENTION ALL YOUTH SHOOTERS: All new youth must shoot a qualifying round for target games (indoor & target rounds) and field games (field/hunter & animal) at a PSAA club monitored by a knowledgeable PSAA member prior to attending a State Championship Tournament. All youth that move from one age group to another must reclassify for the new age group. ****If you choose to classify in a higher age group, you may not switch back. This means choosing to move up in an age group prior to you actually being that age. You will not be permitted to return and compete in the lower age level.**

Field/Hunter & Animal Changes – Youth Divisions:

Intermediates(15-17) – Will shoot the same distances as the adults.

Juniors (12-14) – Will shoot a max of 50 yards (See the listing in the Field/Hunter/Animal Section in the newsletter and on the website.)

Cadets (9-11) – Will shoot a max of 30 yards (See the listing in the Field/Hunter/Animal Section in the newsletter and on the website.)

Pre-Cadets (≤ 8) – Will shoot a max of 30 yards (See the listing in the Field/Hunter/Animal Section in the newsletter and on the website.)

**There will not be a traditional variance for the youth divisions.

Classification: This is an important process and needs to be completed before attending a State Tournament. You can classify at a Regional shoot or at any PSAA member club. If your club is not a PSAA member, contact your regional delegate for help. If you are not classified prior to a State Tournament, you will be placed in the top class of your division for the tournament. The only classification cards that will be accepted at the tournament will be the Official PSAA Classification Card.

RULES FOR ALL TEAMS AT STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

FILLING OUT FORMS: The Team Captain’s Name, Address, and Phone Number **MUST** be on the application form. All communications from the PSAA to the team will be conducted through him/her.

TEAMS: Each team may have any number of members from a single club. Each team shall be registered in advance (registration must be postmarked no later than the cut-off date on the application and the registration shall be accompanied by the required fee.) A late charge will be enforced on any registration mailed after the cut-off date. A club may register one or more men’s teams and one or more women’s teams in each of the following divisions: Barebow, Freestyle (Fingers), Unlimited, Senior Division, Senior-Plus Division, Bowhunter Unlimited, Bowhunter Barebow, Bowhunter Freestyle (Fingers), Longbow, Recurve, and Crossbow, and one or more Youth teams in the Pre-Cadet, Cadet, Junior or Intermediate category. Females of any age may register on women’s teams so long as they all shoot from the same distance. Males and females of any age may register on men’s teams so long as they shoot from the same distance. Youth teams may have males and females on the same team. Youth outdoor rounds requires all team shooters to shoot the same distances, AA distances, as per the team division rules. All team members must shoot the same distances as per the rulebook.

ELIGIBILITY: The registration form shall be signed by both the President and Secretary of the club sponsoring the team, and shall carry a statement attesting to the fact that all of the archers on the team have been bonafide participating members of the sponsoring club for at least 60 days preceding the date of registration. The archers shall be listed by name and address. An archer may represent **ONLY** one club at any one shooting time.

MEMBERSHIP: All Pennsylvania clubs must be members of the PSAA for the current year. All participating archers on Pennsylvania teams must be members of the PSAA for the current year.

RULES: PSAA Rules as printed for the specific round as listed in the PSAA Rule Book.

SCORING: Team scores shall be the sum of the best four (4) total individual scores shot by a registered member of the team. The total score is the two-day total for the individual.

PRIZES: Appropriate awards shall be granted to the top three teams in each division, providing competition warrants the awards. Competition shall be deemed to warrant a prize when at least three teams are competing for the same prize.

EXAMPLE: One award for three teams, two awards for four teams, three awards for five or more teams

Opening Ceremonies & Announcements: Each Tournament will begin with announcements at 8am each day and official scoring to follow. **For the Indoor Tournament Only – there will be second opening announcements at noon for the start of that line with official scoring to follow.

Target assignments: Target assignments will be posted in a designated area for each tournament. If your name is highlighted on the sheet you will need to check in with the registration area. If your name is not highlighted, they you do not need to check in.

Equipment Inspections Bowhunter & Barebow Divisions: Each shooter in these divisions must have their equipment (primary and any back up equipment that may be used) inspected and scorecard verified to determine that the equipment is legal for the division based on the rules found in the PSAA rulebook.

Failure to have this completed during inspection time will result in the shooter being placed in the unlimited division. ** Please note that any archers equipment may be inspected at anytime based on the PSAA rulebook.**

Classification: An announcement will be made prior to the start of practice and you will then be asked to surrender your current Official PSAA classification card to the official. You do not need to present a classification card if you shoot any of the following: **AA class, Traditional Longbow, Traditional Recurve, Senior or Senior-Plus Division, or Crossbow.** Everyone else **must** have an up-to-date classification card. **We absolutely will NOT accept any Conference classification cards.** The classification card you present at this or any other State Championship tournament must be an Official PSAA Classification card. **If you do not have your class card or it is not properly marked, you will be required to shoot AA class.** There is ample time to take care of all classification before the tournament.
